This exhibition is one of the many public outcomes of the Calderdale and Kirklees Cricket Heritage Project based at the University of Huddersfield. The project received a grant of £43,400 from the Heritage Lottery Fund and this was supplemented by an in-kind donation of £7,000 from the University of Huddersfield. The aim has been to explore and reconstruct the social history of each and every cricket club in the Calderdale-Kirklees area. Other clubs have had their exhibitions, and in 2009 it's East Bierley's turn.

Other outcomes of the project have included an annual Pennine Cricket History Conference, an interactive website ([www.ckcricketheritage.org.uk](http://www.ckcricketheritage.org.uk)) which also acts as an electronic archive, traditional archives in Huddersfield and Halifax town libraries established by West Yorkshire Archive Service, activity packs for schools, cricket-themed heritage trails, regular newsletters and workshops, feature articles in the local and national press, and various publications about the history of local cricket.
