J. MAUDE



J. Maude captained the 1st XI during the 1940s and 1950s, as it rose to prominence as one of the leading sides in the area. Under his leadership the Halifax League title was won on five occasions and the Parish Cup once, in the Double-winning 1950 season. In 1956, another title-winning season, he won the Halifax League bowling prize with 56 wickets at 8.3.

BARRY TENNYSON.



Barry Tennyson captained Barkisland to a remarkable array of trophies in the 1970s and 1980s.

He was skipper during the Club's hat-trick of Halifax Parish Cup victories in the 1970s and also won three Halifax League titles, his last in 1984, which was accompanied by another Parish cup success. Then, to finish off with, he was at the helm when the 2nd XI experienced Crossley Shield and league title success in the late 1980s.

Barry is now Chairman of the Halifax Cricket League and a League umpire.

PAUL WINROW



Paul has played for Cleckheaton and Woodlands in the Bradford League as well as Barkisland.

In 2003 he scored 1,392 runs at an average of 107.08 to win the Conference batting prize. In 2004, back in the Premier Division, he rattled up 1,172 runs at an average of 61.68.
