The Annual Mixed Dinner at Ogden Golf Club was very well attended and another success. Thanks to David and Julie Lawton for their organisation.

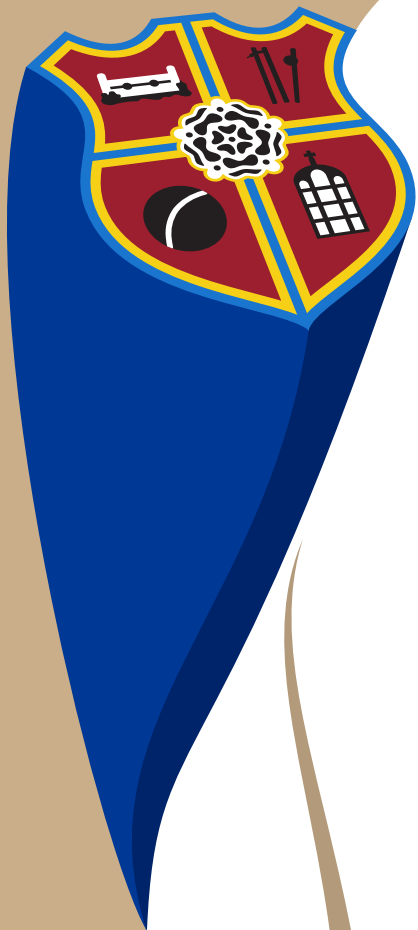


## Sports Quiz Final
