121st AGM

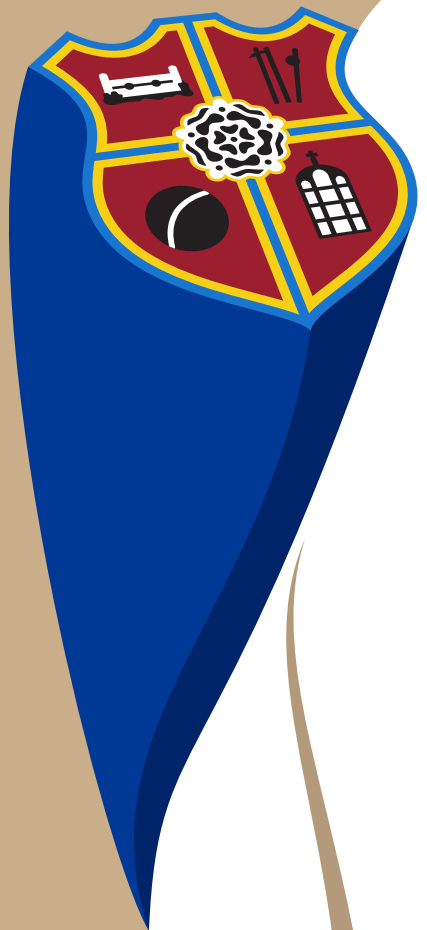

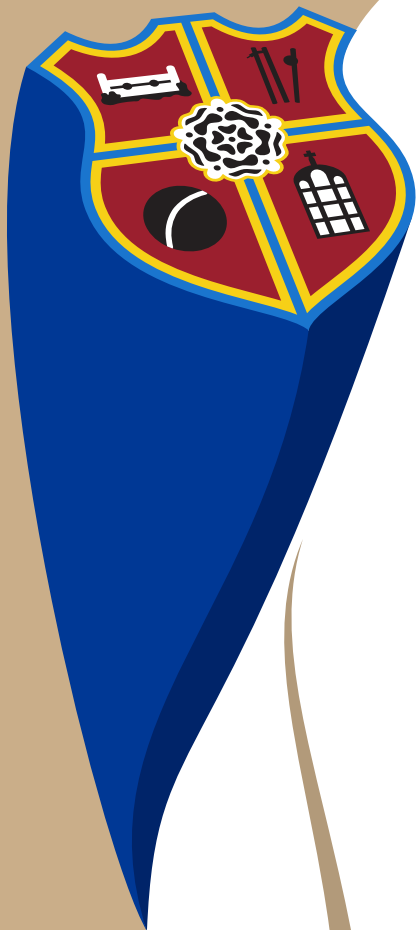
