One of the finest bowlers of his day. He won the Huddersfield League bowling prize in 1936 and 1937.



GORDON SAMPLE

Gordon had one of the most powerful arms in his day. Very few people have thrown a cricket ball over Lockwood Viaduct in Huddersfield. Gordon achieved this feat three times and, for good measure, *bowled* it over a fourth time.

CLIFFORD SYKES

A renowned fielder, Clifford Sykes played in the side which won the Sykes Cup in 1931.

BREFNI HIONS

Brefni Hions is another stalwart who, like Raymond Roebuck, began his playing career with Rastrick in the 1950s and is still involved with the Club.

STUART FLETCHER



Stuart Fletcher played for Rastrick before heading off to Lascelles Hall. He then went on to play for Yorkshire and Lancashire. A bar in the Round Hill pub is named after him. He currently plays for Elland.

AAMIR SOHAIL



Aamir Sohail joined Rastrick as professional for season 1991.

He went on to captain the Pakistan international side but still takes time to look in on Round Hill when he's in the area.

RAYMOND ROEBUCK



Raymond joined Rastrick in the 1950s and was an exceptional bowler in his day. When a back injury ended his career, Raymond joined the 'back room boys' who make sure the Club runs smoothly.

Today he still plays a major role at the Club as one of the trustees. In 1984 he was awarded the Lady Sykes Trophy for his outstanding contribution to the Club and Huddersfield League cricket in general.

JOHN EDGE

John has served the Club for many years, both on and off the field. Today he still plays for the 1st XI and works tirelessly for the club as Secretary and Cricket Chairman.
