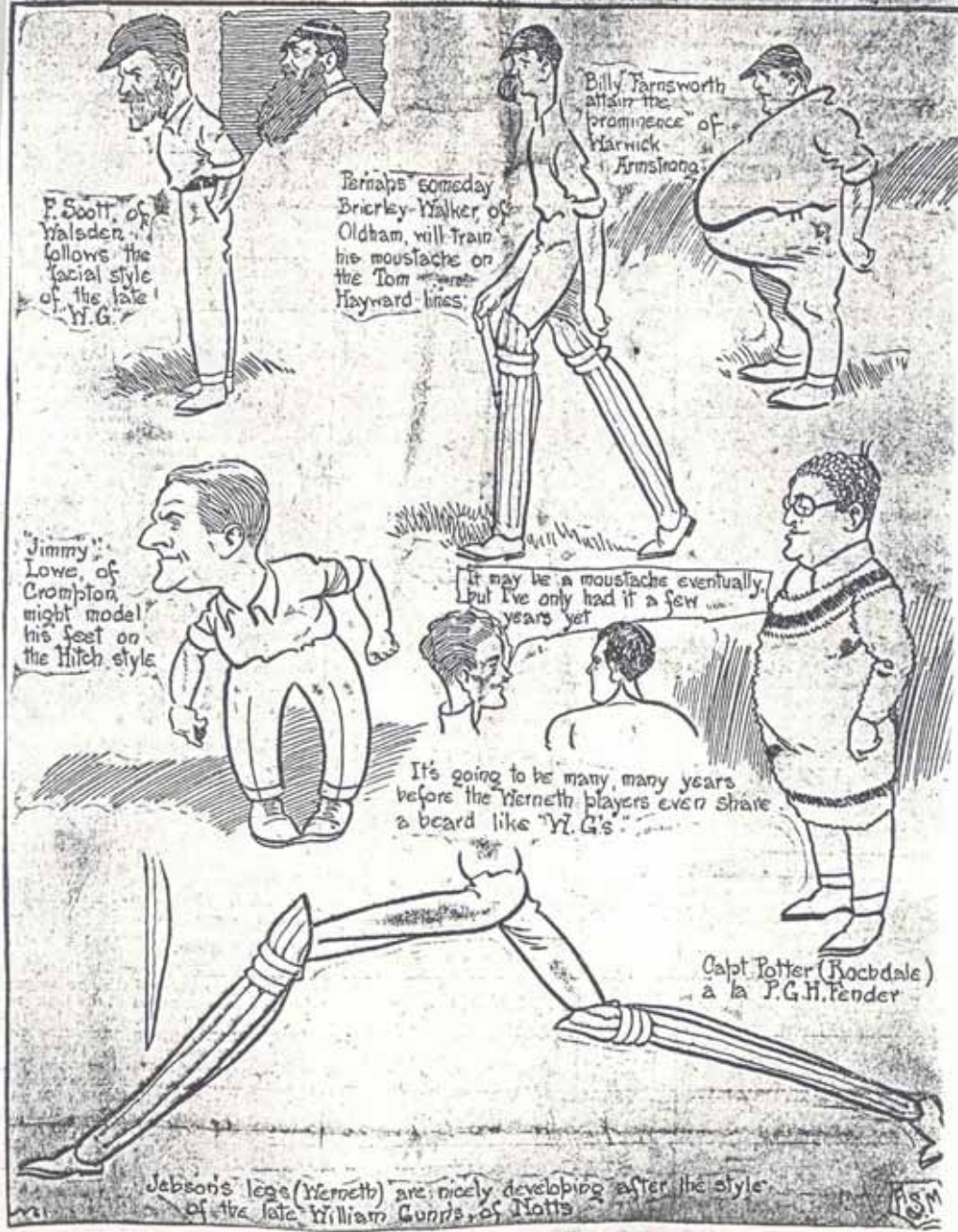


In the Steps of the Great

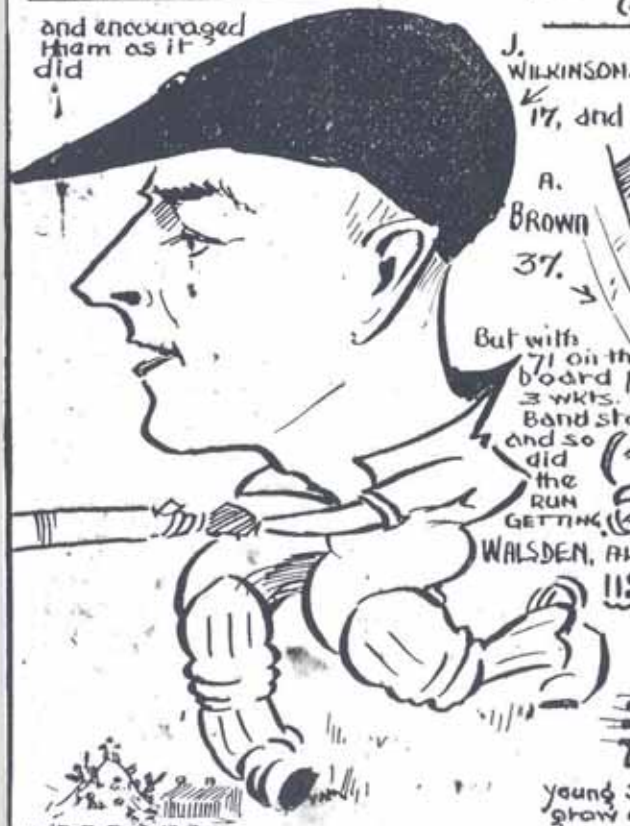
