

Warley and King Cross in Shield final

Long-drawn-out Crossley Shield semi-finals (they began the week before Wakes) finished on Tuesday with victories for Warley and King Cross, who will meet in the postponed final on August 4 and 5 at Greetland.

Warley's innings at Triangle was suspended at 151 for seven and they quickly ended the home side's innings for 52. The course of the match was indicated on Monday evening when six wickets were down for 41. For Warley, J. Regan took seven for 26.

At Highroad Well Barracks, King Cross had made 136 for six when their innings was suspended and Copley were dismissed for 103. R. A. Greenwood taking six wickets for 19 runs.

King Cross now have a chance of winning the Halifax League championship, the Parish Cup and the Crossley Shield.
