

# Surplus for Kirkheaton Cricket Club

INCREASED bar sales, to a record level of £9,372, enabled Kirkheaton Cricket and Bowling Club to enjoy a surplus of £325 on their year's financial statement.

These figures were presented at the club's annual meeting in the clubhouse on Monday night.

Profit on the bar sales totalled slightly over £2,000, while fruit machine profits and revenue from the ground improvement scheme totalled £650.

Largest single item of expenditure was the £189 spent on repairs to the clubhouse, while field maintenance and cricket fees combined totalled £218.

In his report, the secretary, Mr. Geoffrey Barnard, commented on the work already done to improve the clubroom and said there were high hopes of further improvements to toilet facilities, committee room and kitchen. The cricket field itself had shown a marked improvement, thereby justifying the expenditure and hard work put in.

On the playing front, Mr. Barnard said he felt the first eleven had established themselves in the "A" section of the Huddersfield League and they finished the season with only five points fewer than the league champions.

Mr. Barnard thanked the club's professional, Ian Shackleton for his services during the past six years and extended a welcome to the new professional, Brian Collier.
