1912 Letting Agreement

A N A G R E E M E N T made the 13th day
of March 1912 Between THE EARL OF DARTMOUTH
hereinafter called the Landlord, by MESSRS. THYNNE
& THYNNE, of No.9 Victoria Street, Westminster,
his Agents, of the one part, and THE SLAITHWAITE
CRICKET CLUB, of Slaithwaite, near Huddersfield,
herein called the Tenant of the other part.

The Landlord agrees to let, and the Tenant agrees to take ALL that piece of land situate and fronting Raeton Street in the Township of Slaithwaite in the County of York, as shown on plan attached hereto and coloured pink, for the term of One year certain from the 25th day of March 1912, and thenceforth from year to year at the clear yearly rent of Two Pounds sterling, payable quarterly, on the usual Quarter Days, without deduction of any kind (except in respect of Landlord's Property Tax) the first payment of such rent to be made on the 24th day of June next, and to be Ten Shillings.

The Tenant agrees with the Landlord as follows:- To pay the said rent in manner aforesaid, and all existing and future Rates, Taxes and Outgoings whatsoever, payable in respect of the land, Landlord's Property Tax only excepted.

To use the said land as and for Cricket Ground purposes only, and not to do or permit any act or thing upon the land which may be or grow to the annoyance, damage or disturbance of the neighbouring premises.

Not to underlet or part with the possession of the land, or any part thereof, without the previous written consent of

the Landlord or his Agents, and at the expiration of this tenancy, to yield up peaceable possession of the land to the Landlord or his Agents without making any claim for outlay in fencing or improvements to the land of any kind whatsoever.

And it is hereby further expressly agreed that in the event of the Landlord making the street called Racton Street the Tenant shall pay interest yearly at the rate of Five per cent. on the proportion of the cost of such portion of the street as is coloured brown on the plan attached hereto, such sum to be apportioned by the Landlord's Agents.

Provided always that, if, and whenever any quarterly payment of the said rent, &c., shall be in arrears, in whole or in part, for 20 days after the same shall become due, although not lawfully demanded, or if and whenever there shall be a Breach of any of the Agreements hereinbefore on the Tenant's part contained, then and in every such case, it shall be lawful for the Landlord to re-enter on the land hereby agreed to be let and put an end to this tenancy.

For the purposes of this Agreement the term Landlord shall include his heirs and assigns or other the person or persons for the time being entitled to the premises expectant on the determination of this tenancy, and the term Tenant shall include his or her executors, administrators and assigns.

This tenancy may be determined by either party on giving to the other party Six Calendar Months' Notice in writing, expiring on the 25th day of March in the year 1913, or in any subsequent year.
