ENGLAND stars Mark Ramprakash and former England captain Alec Stewart will be heading for Scholes next Spring, as reward for the Chapelgate club winning the Dunlop Slazenger Club Cricket Challenge.

The Surrey duo will take part in a masterclass at Scholes as part of the club's prize for being voted as Yorkshire's top club team.

The club's trophy cabinet was further boosted as their Indian star Wasim Jaffer was also ranked as the top overseas player in the county.

And to complete a good night for the Drakes League at the Club Cricket Challenge presentation evening at

Headingley, Huddersfield also had another three prizewinners.

Delph & Dobcross batsman Darren Shadford won the six-hit event with 35, while Holmfirth's Paul Shaw was second in the wicketkeeping award, a position he shared with Skelmanthorpe's Richard Cocking in the catching category.

As well as the proposed visit of the two Test stars, Scholes were also presented with a cut-glass vase, a Slazenger bat and caps.

Scholes chairman Bob Pell, who was at the awards ceremony to receive the prize on behalf of Jaffer said: "We have to talk to the PR people about their availability, but we're hoping to get

Ramprakash and Stewart over for the day at Chapelgate, possibly sometime in April.

"We'd like to get a masterclass with them during the day, possibly inviting some of the League's juniors along as well, and then perhaps ask them to do a question and answer session in the clubhouse at night."
