

## **£4,500 for cricket club**

BRADSHAW Cricket Club has been awarded a grant of £4,500 by Calderdale Council Leisure Services Committee.

The club in Bradshaw Lane, Bradshaw, Halifax, plans to build a new pavilion and changing rooms costing almost £95,000.

The National Lottery has agreed to give £55,000 towards the work providing the club can raise the outstanding cash.

The club has already raised £5,000 and has applied to the Foundation of Sport and the Arts to make up the shortfall of just over £25,000.

Work on the pavilion is expected to start in April and be completed by the summer. The club has three adult teams and three junior teams in the Halifax league.

Award of Grant

#Acceptance

3 If you wish to accept this award on the terms and conditions stated herein please return one copy of the enclosed Form of Acceptance, duly signed and dated on behalf of the Organisation by two authorised signatories. You should retain the other copy which, together with this letter and subject to paragraph ~ above, will constitute the agreement between the Sports Council and the Organisation. You have six months from the date of this letter to accept the terms and conditions of this award and to send us the documents referred to in paragraph 4 .After this six month period this offer of award will lapse unless valid reasons are given for the delay which are accepted by the Sports Council. If this offer lapses, your application will be treated as having been rejected.
