Meeting April 13th 1953

Meeting November 2nd 1953

D.R. Kershaw reported that the club had been accepted into the Halifax League But had been asked to improve catering facilities and seating arrangements

Meeting April 21st 1954

It was decided to award cap badges to 1st XI players after 7 matches

Meeting April 28th 1954

The Treasurer said the cap badge decision had been hastily arrived at and this effected club finances. These decisions should be put before the committee for approval. This was passed

Meeting April 14th 1955

Scorer's fee Proposed 3p for home matches 6p for away matches. Amended 6p for home and away. The amendment carried

Meeting August 5th 1955

A second hand mower costing 30/- be sent back and a new one bought for £7.10.0p was passed

Meeting August 22nd 1955

Captains of both teams automatically become members of the committee
This rule still stands today 1977

Meeting June 1956

Coaching course H.Andrew to go on the course club to pay his fee.

Meeting December 17th 1956

Loss on Annual Dinner £3.15.0p Bill £21.50p Coop dividend £1.1.0p Entertainers £3.10.0p Ticket money £21.0.0p = Loss
Kershaw and L Waddington be accepted as Life Members this was carried

Meeting March 4th 1957

Equipment bought from Blackboroughs C.C collected Sunday March 3rd
One motor mower 30 gns. 1 new reblade bat 2 sight screens and other items seat tools oil etc. Total cost £36.00
Petrol coupons have been received for the period Feb 16th to April 16th The amount was 2.5 gallons which was not adequate for our needs.

Meeting April 1st 1957

D.R.Kershaw stated that he had had an offer of 6 mahogany seats for 5/- each. T Pollard suggested we buy them and then sell them to members to have name plates put on them.
