

Meeting February 1st 1960

The minutes of the last meeting were read and R. Baldwin proposed seconded by D. Kershaw that they be accepted as a true record.

Correspondence: A letter was received along with application form re. Training Course organised by Yorkshire Cricket Club. to commence February 10th. J. Corbett said he had already forwarded his application therefore it was agreed that the club should pay his fees of 10/-

Ground Work: D. R. Kershaw reported that he had been in touch with the owner of the field which runs alongside the cricket field, but he had declined the attempt to have part of his field to extend the cricket field. Therefore we would have to rebuild the wall which had collapsed.

Sunday Fixtures: Smith Bulmers had wrote requesting a Sunday fixture with us reported D. Evans. After discussion it was decided to offer them a fixture in August the date of which was to be arranged later.

J. Corbett then made a suggestion that we should in future run a 40 weeks season in future, and do away with the football tickets in winter. Various opinions were put forward on this matter but nothing definite was decided upon.
