This agreement is binding on both parties to the end of Season 1932, subject to the said Kirkheaton Cricket and Bowling Club and the said Arthur H. Noble agreeing to terminate by mutual consent this agreement on or before the last Saturday in September 1932.

The said agreement shall be dissolved by each party signing to that effect.
