

KIRKBURTON CRICKET SPORTS AND SOCIAL CLUB

Job Specification for the Cricket Committee ( amended)

The purpose of the Cricket Committee is to govern all matters concerning the game of cricket. This is essentially a sub-committee of the General Committee and should at all times be responsible to the General Committee. The budget allotted to the Cricket Committee shall be determined by the General Committee. The Cricket Committee along with the Cricket Selection Committee shall have autonomy and responsibility in the following matters: -

1. The selection of all playing members for each game for the First and Second Elevens.
2. Be responsible for instructing the Groundsman of the needs of all teams using the Club ground.
3. The engaging of players for both the First and Second Eleven teams. In the case of players requiring fees or re-embursement, any monies paid shall be negotiated by the approved members of the Cricket Committee without further reference to the General Committee but in no case shall the total sum exceed the budget allotted by the General Committee.
4. Ensuring that players requiring fees or re-embursment have signed agreement with the Club before playing for the Club.
5. Ensuring that the Club is represented at all meetings of the Cricket Leagues and where necessary Cup Meetings.
6. By means of it's representatives on the General Committee, keep the General Committee informed of all matters concerning the teams and the decisions that are made in the Cricket Committee.
7. By the same representatives, the Cricket Committee must be informed of those decisions made in the General Committee that effect the Cricket Committee.
8. Liase with the General Committee on all matters and decisions that are taken by the General Committee that are for the benefit and wellbeing of the Club.
