INSTRUCTIONS

The Walk starts from the Cricket Field at Hedge Top at 9 a.m.

Free Refreshments will be available at the following check points -

Crossley's Cricket Club
Warley Cricket Club
Copley Cricket Club
Brookfoot Checkpoint
Northowram H. T. C. C.

The route will be sign posted. Please ensure that your card is signed by an official at each check point and when you have completed the walk or retired. All monies should reach the Club Treasurer Mr. H. Andrew 59, Newlands Grove, Northowram, by November 3rd. 1967.

ROUTE

Down Westercroft - right at Denholme Gate Road - right Hipperholme lights and then bear left down Shibden Hall Road - Old Bank - Bank Bottom - Church Street Shaw Hill (Shay on right) cross Huddersfield Road - onto Skircoat Green Road - turn right onto Skircoat Moor Road - left Broomfield Road. Check point (1) Old Crossleyans. Left Birdgase Lane - turn right onto Albert Promenade - left onto Skircoat Moor Road. Through lights at left down Rochdale Road - right at Willow Hall Lane - onto Steps Lane and left at Burnley Road. Right Blackwall Lane on Hill Lane and Cliff Hill Lane to Check point (2) Warley C.C. On Stock Lane - cross Roils Head Road to Court Lane - bear right Highroad Well Lane down Sandbeds Road - crossing Moor End Road and left at Doctor Hill then right at Wood Lane - bear left along Scar Head and right at Denfield Lane - bear left along Cousin Lane and right at Keighley Road - 150 yds Check point (3) Crossley C.C. gates † on Keighley Road - bear left at Beech Wood Road - turn left at Shay Lane and bear right to Holdsworth Road and Brow Lane. Turn right at Crooked Lane - cross Queensbury Road and turn right up Bradford Old Road to Checkpoint (4) Red Lion, Ploughcroft. Left down Lee Lane and down past Shibden Mill Inn. Continue up Blake Hill straight across Brow Lane - onto Howes Lane and onto Towngate and Lydgate and Checkpoint (5) Northowram Hedge Top Cricket Club
