

## **Shepley Cricket Club 2007 AGM**

### **Press Release**

Shepley Cricket Club held its Annual General Meeting at the Farmers Boy pub in Shepley on Sunday 11 March.

Among the items on the agenda were the re-elections of officers and the committee, with Richard Haigh being elected club president, replacing the outgoing Graham Leslie.

Elsewhere there were no other major changes to the officials, with David Hall continuing as club chairman. Ian Watkinson resumes his roles as vice-chairman, secretary and league representative, while Chris Armitage and Steve Fitton remain as bar secretary and treasurer respectively. Gary Booth will also continue as umpires representative.

Meanwhile, Gary Flannery has resigned from the club committee, and will be replaced by Mel Briggs, the former club secretary. Julian Driver has also left the committee, while Barry Seal has relinquished his duties as both committee member and sponsorship secretary. Otherwise the committee remains as before.

Elsewhere, player memberships fees will again be £65, reduced to £55 if paid before 31 May. The only changes in membership prices apply to junior and family membership. Juniors will now be required to pay £10, but will benefit from coaching with new overseas player Trent Copeland throughout the season. Meanwhile, family memberships have been slightly increased to £25.

Plans for the forthcoming Shepley Spring Festival were also discussed, with the club's Marsh Lane ground hosting the event. The club will also be running three bars, including a beer tent at the ground and a bar in the Shepley Church Hall.
