## Death of top professional

ONE of the Huddersfield Cricket League's top professionals of the past, Arthur Noble, has died aged 82.

The left-arm paceman and swing bowler is probably best remembered for his six for 3 return when Huddersfield were dis-

missed for six in reply to Holmfirth's 30 in their match in September, 1943.

Shepley-born Mr Noble, who was also an aggressive batsman, played with eight clubs in his 25-year career, 12 of them as a professional.

He helped Elland lift the championship in 1933 and claimed 93 victims for Thongsbridge in 1941. His other clubs were Holmfirth, Shepley, Kirkheaton, Primrose Hill, Golcar and Friar-mere.

In one match Mr Noble took six for 35 in 27 overs as the opposition raced to 200-7 and he also had a six-wicket return when Lancashire and England opener Harry Makepeace brought a select side to play Friar-mere.
