

R U L E S

OF THE

TODMORDEN CRICKET CLUB,

Adopted at a General Meeting of the Members, 2nd May, 1839.

1. That MR. SAMUEL FIELDEN be Treasurer, and MR. JOSEPH FIRTH Secretary.
2. That there be a Committee of nine members, (five to form a quorum,) for transacting the general business of the Club;—and that the Treasurer and Secretary be additional members of the Committee.
3. That the following members form the Committee:—

MR. RICHARD SMITH,	MR. THOMAS BARLOW,	MR. JAMES CHAMBERS,
" THOMAS DAVIS,	" RICHARD CHAFFER,	" GEORGE DOBSON,
" WILLIAM PILLING,	" WILLIAM LORD,	" JOHN BLOMLEY.
4. That the Subscription be One Shilling per month, and Half a Crown Entrance Money.
5. That Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays be the Playing Days.
6. That Saturday be the general Field Day.
7. That an Umpire be appointed each Playing Day.
8. That the Fieldsmen be under the direction and control of the Bowlers;—and that the Committee have power to exclude any Fieldsmen who persists in disobeying the orders of the Bowlers.
9. That any member going over or under the fences, (except in following the Ball,) be fined Sixpence; such fine to be paid to the Treasurer before he can be allowed to play in any game.
10. That the Club be governed by the Rules of the Mary-le-bone Cricket Club.
11. That the Committee have power to purchase Bats, Balls, Wickets, &c., for the use of the Club.
12. That the Committee have power to fix days on which Matches shall be played, (not oftener than once a month,) and to decide what members shall be the Players at such Matches;—also to levy a fine on members so nominated who do not attend.
13. That all new members be admitted by ballot of the Committee.
14. That no person residing within one mile of the Field, be allowed to play more than three times, unless he be a member, but any member may introduce a stranger.
15. That the Secretary call a Meeting at the request of any five members.
16. That the Monthly Meetings for paying the Subscriptions, be held at the White Hart Inn, Todmorden, on the first Monday in each Month, at Eight o'Clock in the Evening.
17. That these Rules be not altered except at a general Meeting of the members.
18. That these Rules be printed, and a copy sent to each member.
