The following resolutions were passed.

1. Proposed H. Throst Seconded E. Johnson that the minutes of the last Annual General Meeting be passed as a true & correct record.
2. Proposed G. Johnson Seconded J. Simpson that the Balance Sheet & Statement of accounts be accepted & the Hon Secy & Hon Auditor be thanked for their services.
3. Proposed J. Simpson Seconded H. Throst that the Hon Secy's report be accepted & he be thanked for his services.
4. Proposed G. Throst Seconded J. Simpson that 1 cwt of coal oil be purchased for use on ground.
5. Proposed H. Throst Seconded G. Throst that in view of the National Emergency the election of officers for next year be held over until early in the New Year date to be fixed later. H. Throst stated he did not wish to accept the office for a further period.
6. Proposed Rev. G. R. Hall Seconded H. Throst that a hearty vote of thanks be given to the retiring officials, & special thanks be extended to Mr Arthur Cook, Mr Robert Ellis for their efforts in the re-formation of the club.
7. Proposed H. Throst Seconded E. Johnson that thanks be extended to the Vicar for presiding at the meeting and allowing us the use of the Church House for the meeting.
