

## Report Season 1901.

The Committee have again very great pleasure in placing before you a record of the past seasons work. Out of 22 Matches arranged for the 1<sup>st</sup> XI 20 have been played of which 10 have been won 12 Lost & 3 Drawn. The number of runs scored being 1827 for the loss of 189 wickets, giving an average of 9.6 per wicket & 87 Runs per Innings & their opponents 1757 for the loss of 155 Wickets, giving an average of 11.33 runs per wicket & 80.6 per Innings. 22 Matches were arranged for the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI out of which 19 were played, 13 being Won 3 Lost. 2 Drawn. 1 tie. The number of Runs being scored 1080 for the loss of 130 wickets, which gives an average of 8.3 runs per wicket & 50 Runs per Innings, to their opponents 1025 Runs which gives an average of 6.06 per wicket & 53 Runs per Innings.

Batting Prizes given by the President for the best qualified Average Batters in the 1<sup>st</sup> XI has been won by Albert Huxtable with an average of 13.3 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI by Edwin Hutchiffe with an average of 12.14. Bowling Prizes given by Mr. Marsden for the Best qualified Average Bowlers have been won in the 1<sup>st</sup> XI by Clement Hickles with an average of 3.51. & in the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI by Grove Littles with an average of 4.96. Fielding Prizes given by Dr. Whittle for the Best Fielder during the season have been in the 1<sup>st</sup> XI by Harry Austinwick & Clement Hickles with 4 Matches each & in the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI by Percy Dooreu with 9 Matches. Catching Prizes given by Mr. J. F. Ramsden for the Player making the most Catches have been won in the 1<sup>st</sup> XI by John Burchcliffe with 14 Catches & in the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI by John Learley with 8 Catches. An Extra Prize given by Mr. D. Litch for the 2<sup>nd</sup> best qualified Average Batter in the 1<sup>st</sup> XI has been won by Herbert Bellwell with an average of 12.95.

The Number of Members on our books are 53 made up with 23 Honorary Members & 30 Playing Members. The Balance Sheet Shows that during the year the Income amounted to £43.6.0½ against an expenditure of £45.5.9½ which leaves a balance against the club of £1.19.9.
