Committee Meeting in the Tent July 16 07.

This meeting was called specially to consider the little bit

 called upon to do so. The Committee did not wish to make any
 special minute on this matter & was very sorry that anything
 had turned up to mar the good feeling which existed & expressed a
 wish that Everett would apologise & settle the matter amicably
 between themselves. This seemed however out of court altogether.

 think otherwise but eventually it was resolved that the whole

thing be left in the hands of the Committee to settle which they
 had perfect confidence they would be able to do - It was decided
 that we should commence digging at once & take each end first &
 about 5 fms in width right along the bottom side & we to do
 what we could in taking out & levelling up -
