The minutes of meeting held 28.9.61
were passed as read.

The secretary told the meeting that
he had sent a message of condolence to
Mrs S.O. Whitley upon the death of her
husband.

Informing the meeting that he had
returned raffle tickets in connection with
Fred Gruenans benefit, the secretary said
that he felt that we may be prepared
to make a subscription.

It was proposed, seconded that a
subscription of £1.1.0 be sent - this was
carried.

The Fred Beverly Trophy was discussed
& it was proposed, seconded, & carried
that this should be a second team
trophy. The Memorial Cup for the first
team & the Memorial Shield for the
third team.

Discussing the qualifications for awarding the trophies it was agreed that the awarding of points for best batting, bowling & fielding averages should still operate. To qualify for the trophies, a player must take part in at least fifty percent of the matches for any one trophy.

The secretary asked if paint could be bought, with a view to brightening up the pavilion. It was proposed, seconded & carried that paint be bought.

One or two members volunteered to carry out the painting & it was left to these members to carry on as soon as paint was available.
