Business of the meeting to consider
& vote upon the proposed alteration
to rule 15.

a) That on the election of officers at the
annual General Meeting, any member
present under the age of 16 at the date
of the meeting, shall be entitled to
vote, but that each vote shall be
counted as half a vote.

b) That on electing the captains & vice
captains of the ~~various~~ various teams
any nomination shall be voted, but
after votes have been cast & no nominee
has an overall majority of the meeting,
then the nominee receiving the lowest
number of votes shall be eliminated.

Further ballots shall then be held
until in the same way until one
nominee has the necessary overall
majority.
