The following are proposals from the Honley Cricket Club and the Huddersfield Hockey Club, regarding the drainage of the cricket field and the erection of the pavilion, which are to be put before the Honley Cricket Ground Trustees Committee for their approval on 5th August, 1958.

- (1) That the Huddersfield Hockey Club pay all capital expenses in respect of the new pavilion and drainage schemes.
- (2) Huddersfield Hockey Club to pay £55 per year rent for use of the field.
- (3) The lease of the field in the first instance be for a tenure of 21 years, with an option of a further lease
- (4) Each Club be responsible for their own expenses with the exception that the whole of the rates, lighting and water be split 2/3 Hockey Club, 1/3 Cricket Club.
- (5) That the ground be inspected at the end of the Hockey season by members of both committees and the Hockey playing areas be made good to the satisfaction of the Cricket Committee.
- (6) Each Club be responsible for running the bar during their playing seasons. At the handover of stock, the Club handing over must meet all losses or keep all profits.
