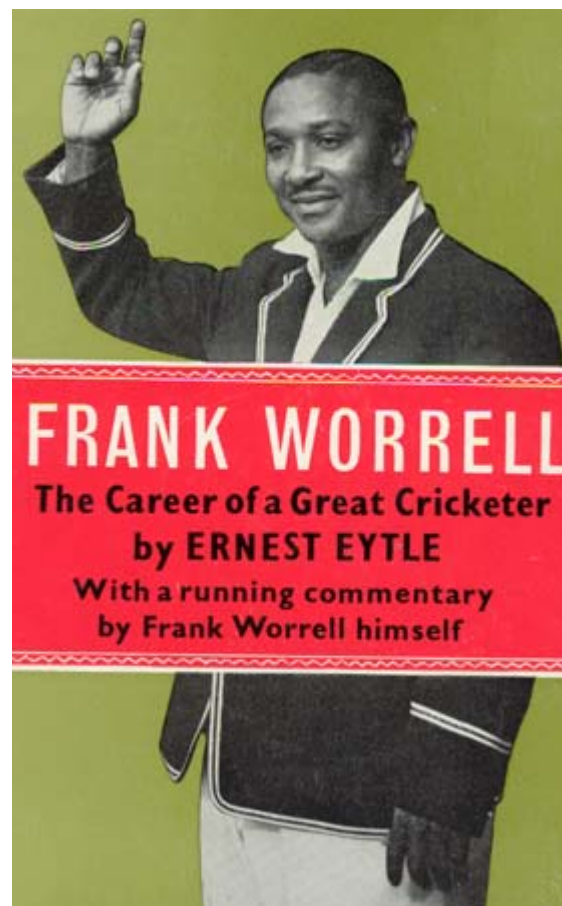


FRANK AND CHARLIE
