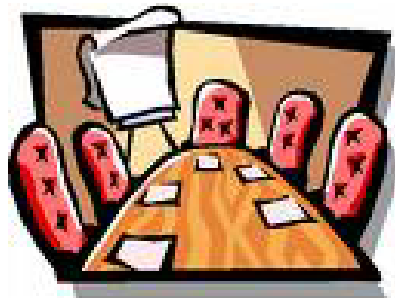


MONDAY MORNINGS
