

1947 Agreement for Use of Ground by Holme Valley Evening League

AN AGREEMENT made this 10 day of MAY 1947,

BETWEEN the Honley Cricket Club AND the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League.

The Honley Cricket Club hereby agree to allow the use of the Cricket Field to the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League on the following terms and conditions :-

1. Cricket Matches shall be played on Mondays and Fridays unless other dates are sanctioned by the Committee of the Honley Cricket Club. The First Match shall commence 5th. May 1947 and the last Match 28th. September 1947.
2. The payment per Match to be Thirty Shillings (30/-). If a Match is not commenced, no Charge will be made, but if a game be started and abandoned the full charge of 30/- will be paid.
3. The Charge of 30/- per Match to include the use of Tackle and Equipment of the Honley Cricket Club. Umpires will be found by the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League.
4. The Fees for the use of the Cricket Field etc. will be paid monthly to a responsible Official of the Honley Cricket Club who will give a Receipt therefor.
5. It is distinctly understood that one Match only will be played each evening.
6. The Honley Cricket Club agree for the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League to make Collections at the Matches. (No Charges to be made at the Gate).
7. Owing to the scarcity and high cost of Cricket Equipment it is hoped the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League will take great care of Cricket Equipment, and in the event of any wanton damage to Equipment then the Holme Valley Works Evening Cricket League will be held responsible.

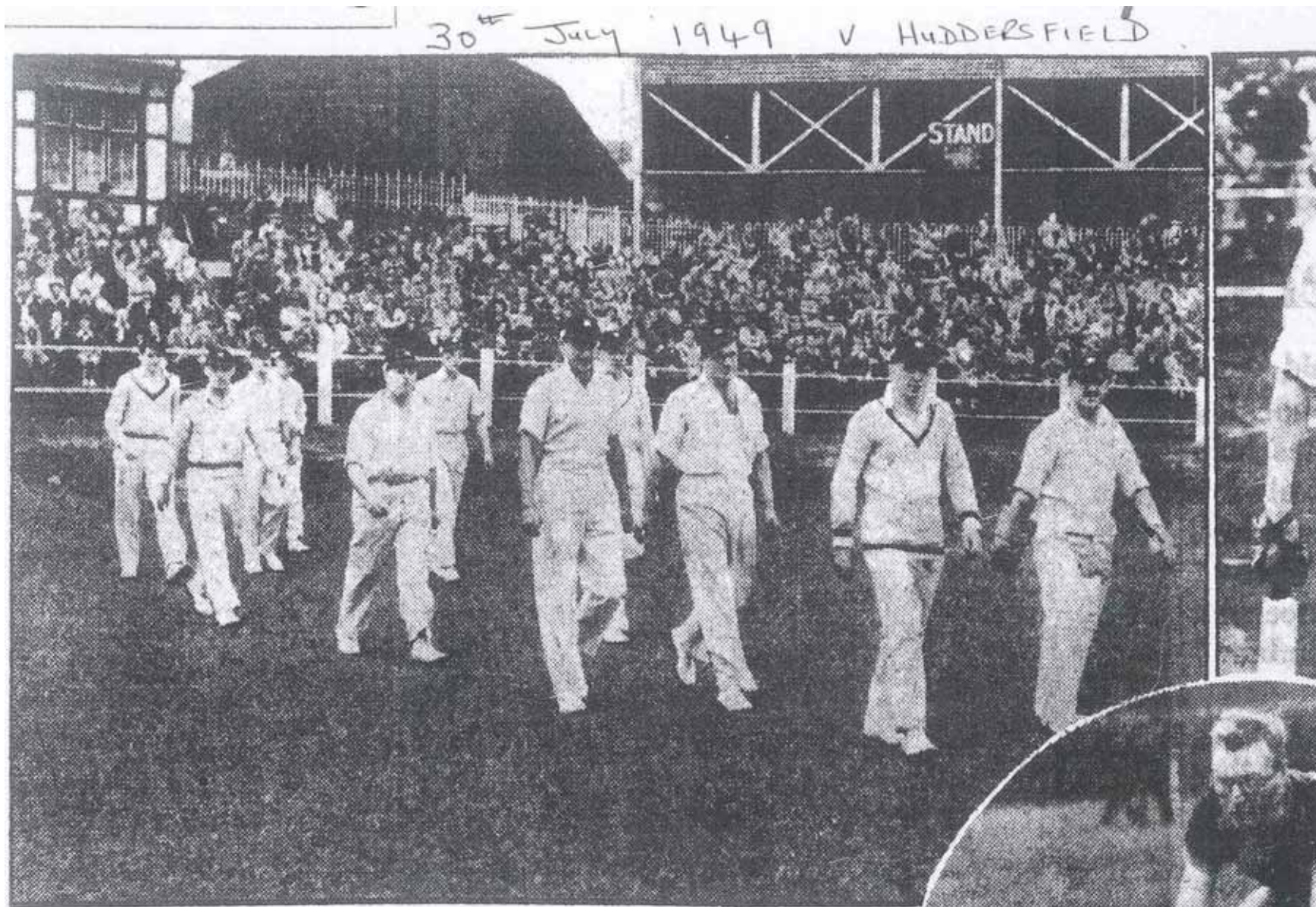
