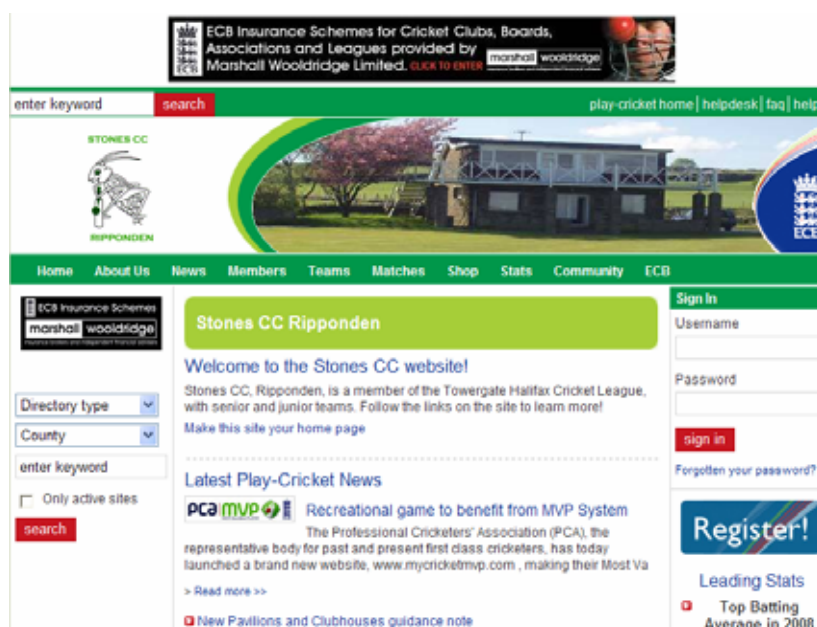


LOTS OF PAPERWORK
