In the 1960s and 1970s we had a railway carriage for a pavilion. There was no hot water - we had to get water from across the other side of the field. We just had a gas burner and an old kettle. There was no electricity.



I think we probably had around eight women on the tea rota – wives and girlfriends.

We used to do teacake sandwiches and bake our own cakes during the week. The tea ladies provided the sweet.

The old railway carriage was about a quarter of the size of the new pavilion...but we were quite fond of it.
