

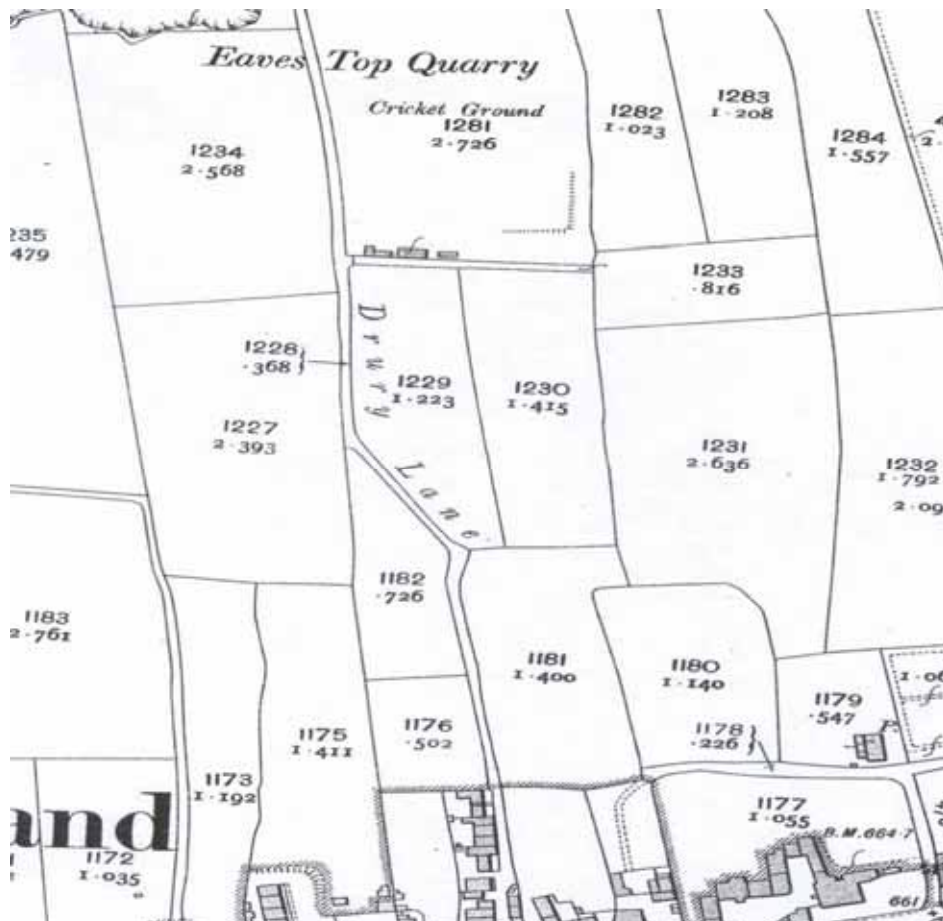
Stainland Cricket Club



Present-Day Map

Stainland CC's roots can be traced back to 1884. From the years 1884-1922 the club's home was Drury Lane - a venue famous for its bandstand. In 1922 the club received their current ground on Stainland Road as a post-war present. It was therefore christened the Memorial Ground (see #31).
