

HONLEY CRICKET CLUB

On the 21st of March 1881 a lease was drawn up between Mr. John Scott of Far End house and the Honley Cricket Club to let the field as a Cricket field for the Honley Cricket Club.

In 1928 the field was owned by a family called "Waddington" of Field End House who emigrated to America.

Mr. Harry Holdroyd and Mr. George Borwell and a group of local business men bought the field for the Honley Cricket Club for £628.

The ground is now left in trust to the Honley Cricket Club ground trustees and the Honley Cricket Club.
