BOWLED, CAUGHT, L.B.W., NOT WICKET, STUMPER, short or helmet, outside and are allowed in Bowling Analysis when they are. RUN OUT, BATTERS BALL, NO BALL TWICE, INTERESTING FEEL, or NOT count as Bowlers, wickets. Run taken possession before a batsman is RUN OUT counts to the Bowlers and against the batsman. NO BALLS - If the ball is bowled from a full toss, then the ball should be bowled in both Bowling and Bowling Analysis and a dot with a circle round it in the Bowling record to show that one ball from each bowler in the team. Runs or Leg Buns bowled from a full toss are counted as No Balls and the No Ball itself does not count, being regarded as a dot with a circle round it. If a run is scored from the bat off a No Ball, then it is credited to the Bowlers and counts against the Batters in the same way as a run scored from a full toss. A No Ball is not counted in the team. WIDES - A Wide is entered in both Bowling and Bowling Analysis and counts as a dot with a circle round it in the Bowling record to show that one ball from each bowler in the team. Runs or Leg Buns resulting from a Wide Ball are counted as Wides and a circle round it in the Bowling record and the ball from which they result is recorded in the Bowling Analysis (with a dot).
