Club captain Bill Hankey broke his own club record in the Yorkshire Century 12 hour event on Sunday. He finished 5th with 241.4 miles (three miles better than his previous record), and won third handicap prize.

Although Hankey lost about four miles in the first 25 miles, he gradually built up a speed of 20 miles per hour. In the Heavy Woollen Combine a few weeks ago he increased his record from 235 to 238 miles.

Arthur Firth, also competing in the 12 hour event, was pipped on the post by Bill Hankey for the third handicap. He had covered 231½ miles, 15 miles better than his Heavy Woollen Combine ride. This is his first season of racing since returning from Hong Kong.
