Sheard Cup Final

overs, six maidens, six wickets for seven runs.

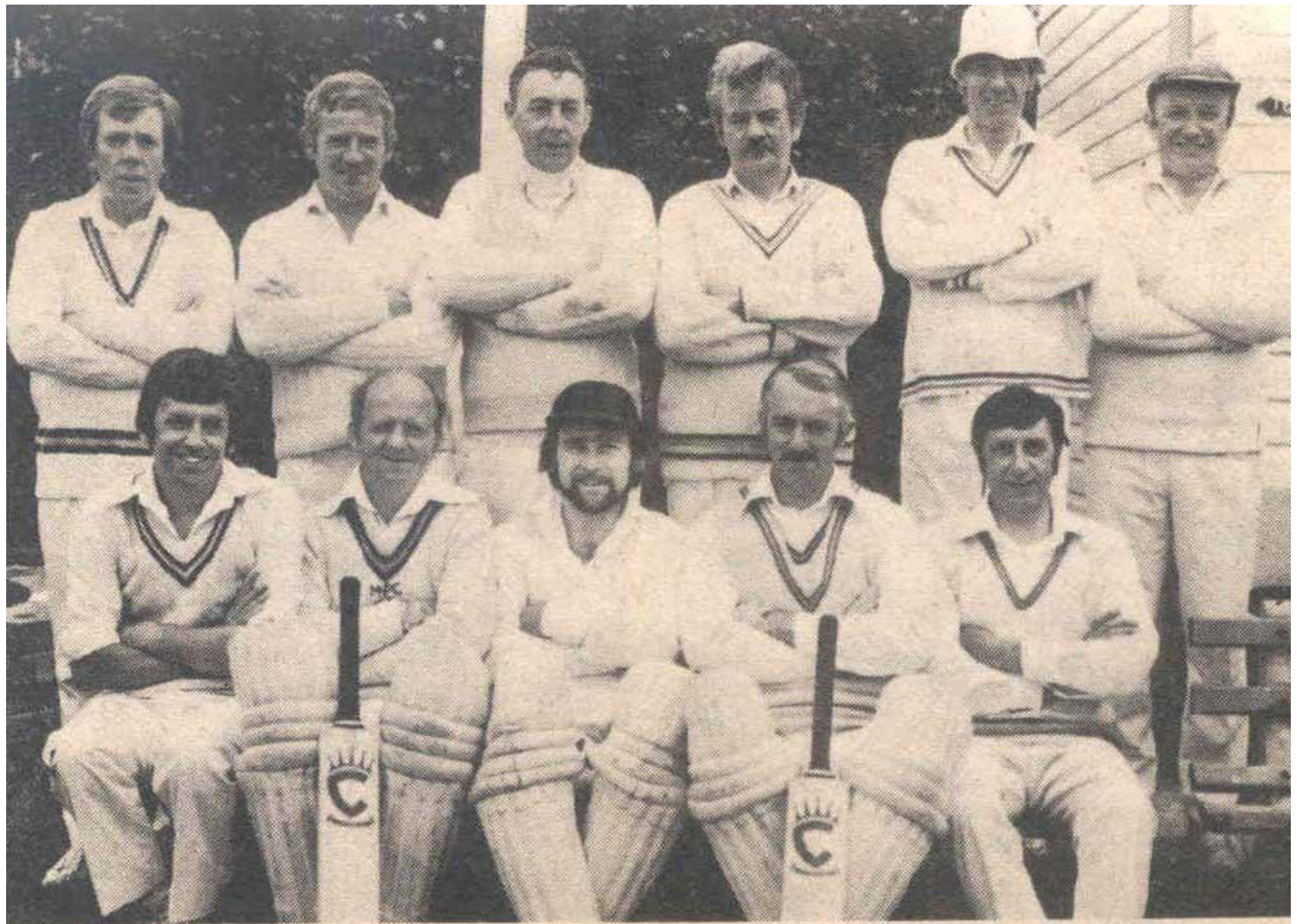
