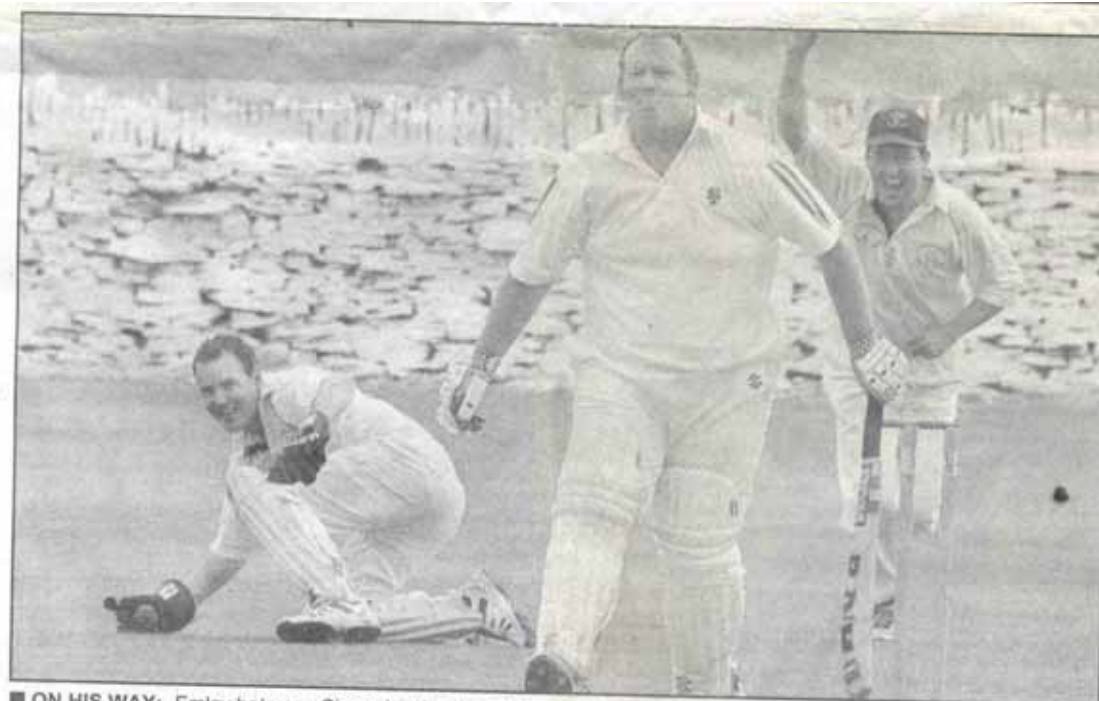

# Allsop final is Sykes Cup repeat

THIS season's Allsop Cup final is, coincidentally, a re-run of the first round of this season's Romida Sykes Cup.

Emley Clarence (who won that clash back in May) and Cumberworth both won their respective Allsop semis to set up another Cup repeat.

League leaders Cumberworth sailed to a 166-run win over Durkar in one semi-final at Penistone, but the second-placed club in the Premiership, Emley, had a much closer call against plucky Section A side Westborough, winning by just two runs in a thrilling finish.

Emley were bowled out for 148 by N Finnigan (6-56) and J Mitchell (4-85) with Jon Lee top-scoring with 34 and Ken Taylor adding 24.

But at 105-5, Westborough

with Finnigan having made 32, seemed set for victory until Lee came back at the end and struck with three late wickets to finish with five for 41 and pull the Dewsbury team up short.

At Penistone, James Bower (80) and Chris Kilner (57) put on 126 for the fifth wicket to hoist Cumberworth's total to a challenging 243-6 against their Section B opponents.

Durkar were soon in trouble when they replied, losing an incredible six wickets with the score standing on 34 as Richard Greaves and Martin Kilner ripped the underdogs apart.

Greaves finished with five for 17 and Kilner three for 16 as Durkar were shot out for 77.
