### THE HIGHEST SCORE FOR 100 YEARS

*(Fenton Brook)*

On June 27th 1942 Fenton Brook scored 200 for Almondbury in a home match against Lockwood. This is a record for time limit cricket in Huddersfield. Under different rules there has been a score of 211 which is the league record.

Fenton Brook who played before, during and after the second war, was a fine all-rounder. He completed the league double of 500 runs and 50 wickets several times.

As can be imagined, he was a very hard hitting batsman, and regularly completed his fifty in very short time. He combined strength with flexibility, and immaculate timing, and was devastating on occasions. He was also a useful seam bowler who maintained an accurate length.
