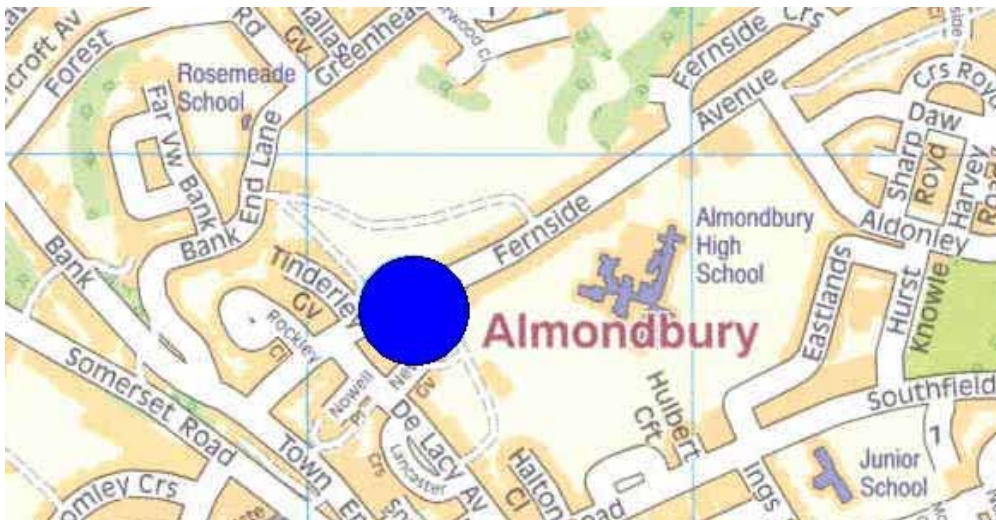


FERNSIDE AVENUE, ALMONDBURY CC

Almondbury Cricket Club is based at Fernside Avenue, Almondbury. Much of the original ground was created by early club members themselves. The fact that little has changed at the ground since then is testament to the work and dedication of those past Almondburians. The one major development at Fernside Avenue is the new pavilion which was opened in 1989 and partly funded by the Sports Council.

Although little has changed at the ground itself, there have been many developments in the surrounding area. Almondbury is a good example of a club that began life as a 'rural' club but now exists very much as an 'urban' one - reinforced by the fact that the ground lies in close proximity to no less than three schools. The fact that so much development has taken place around the club, yet the ground remains unaltered, shows much about the importance of the club to local people.
