Lorraine's award-winning knock not enough Rastrick lift Lumb Cup

RASTRICK NEW ROAD completed the first part of an intended double when they captured the Lumb Cup at Woodfield Park on Sunday.

The Huddersfield Cricket Association joint Section "A" leaders defeated Section "B" side Storthes Hall by 76 runs in the final.

Paceman Deniz Nurse had New Road in trouble at 19-2. Gary Holland then survived an early chance and went on to ride his luck with some fine shots which took him to 75 and New Road to 173-6 after sharing a second-wicket 83-run stand with opener Don Wilson.

The hospital side's innings began disastrously and they were 8-3 and 57-5 against the pace of Bryan Mordecai.

Only Peter Loraine, who had excelled in the field, coped and he went on to make a gritty 35 which earned him the Woodhead Trophy man-of-the-match award.

Once he was out, how-

ever, the hospital side lost their last four wickets for five runs and were all out for 97, Mordecai claiming five for 11 from 12 overs.

Skipper Trevor Clayton received the cup from league president John Harold, whose Augustinians side are joint top of Section "A" with New Road.
