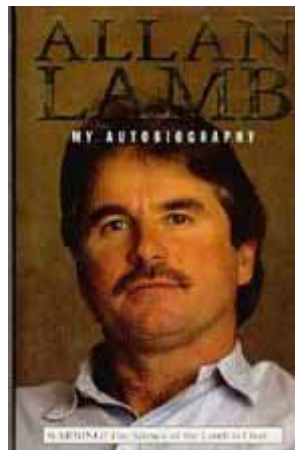


# SOUTH AFRICANS AND LANCASTRIANS
