Wickets fall cheaply and then Hopton side recover

FORMER Staincliffe and Mirfield all-rounder Graham Peacock was in form for Mirfield Parish Church against Cross Bank Muslims in a Dewsbury and District League Section 'A' match.

Peacock hit 64 when Mirfield Parish replied with 155-4 in reply to Cross Bank's total of 153 and Smith, with six for 59, also played a leading part in a win by six wickets. Pandor (50) and Malik (39) had good knocks for Muslims.

Horbury Bridge were all out for 50 against Upper Hopton, for whom Clark took five for 20 and Castle captured four for 27. Three wickets fell cheaply when Hopton replied, but Richardson (27 not out) and Bennett (22 not out) shared a match-winning stand.

David Buckley and Barry Geering bowled unchanged for Homfray Carpets when Batley Muslims were dismissed for 47 in reply to a total of 111. Buckley claimed six wickets for 32 and Geering had a return of four wickets for 11.

Wrenthorpe, Section 'A' leaders, defeated Dewsbury Moorlands by seven wickets. After a good opening partnership between Grinhaff (25) and Lightfoot (15), there was a collapse in the middle of the innings and Moorlands were all out for 84. Wrenthorpe won by seven wickets.
