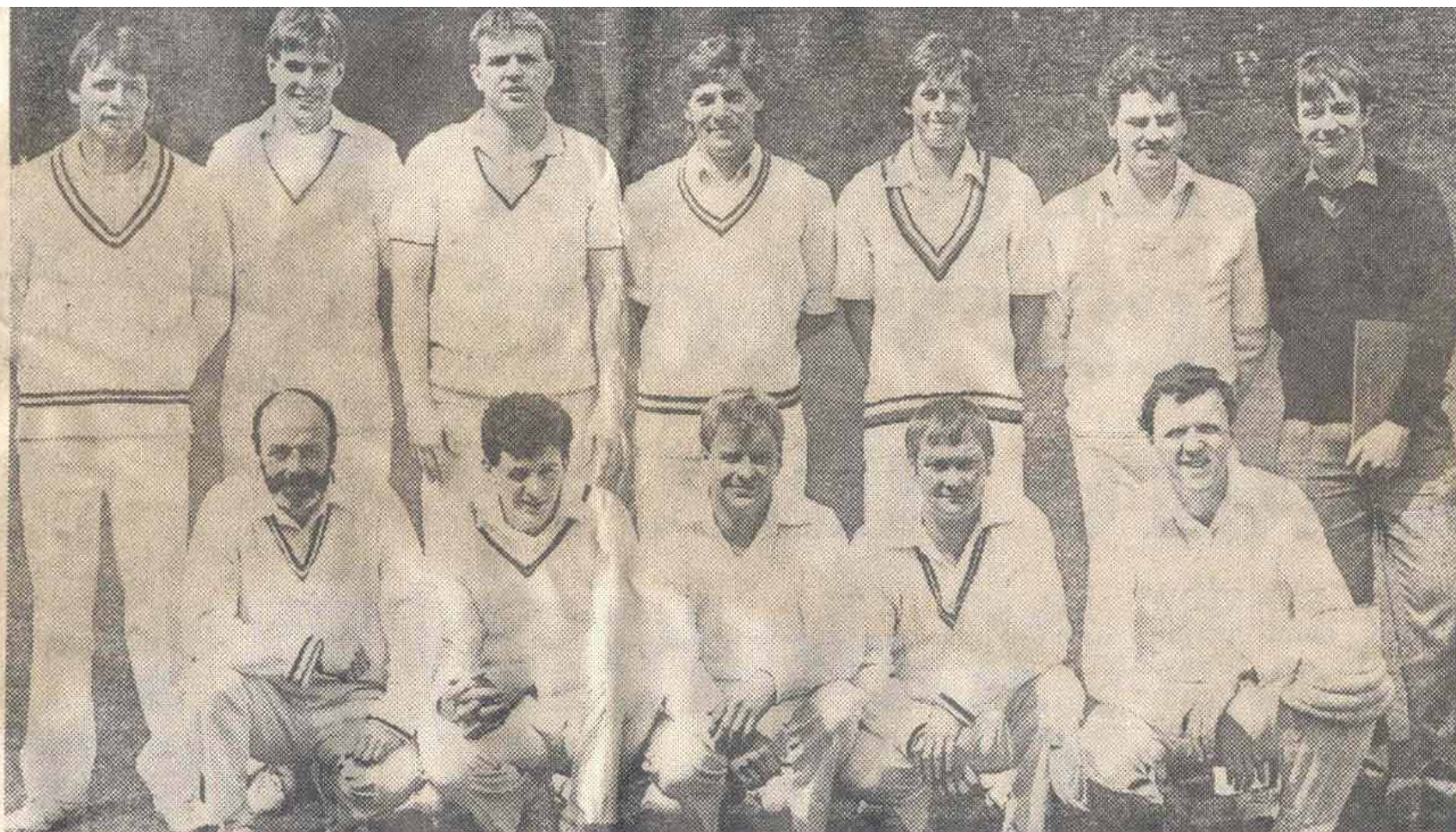


Cup goes back to Holmbridge for the first time since 1958

HOLMBRIDGE lifted the Huddersfield Central League's Tinker Cup for the first time since 1958 with victory over Almondbury Wesleyans in the second team final at Thurstonland.

Ian Parr was the man-of-the-match, making an unbeaten 42 in 22 overs and adding 82 in the last 10 with the big-hitting David Hinchliffe and junior Dave Milner.

Holmbridge reached 195-7 and, after Hinchliffe had retired from the attack due to leg trouble after bowling 6.4 overs, juniors Peter Smith and Milner kept the Wesleyans in check despite a half-century from opener Alan Schofield.

Parr came on second change and wrapped up the innings with four for nine from 4.2 overs to give Holmbridge a 92-run victory.
