

Trueman's all-round feat as Dale take Allsop Cup

DENBY DALE won the Allsop Cup in a rather disappointing final at Penistone when they beat Cawthorne by seven wickets.

Batting first Cawthorne were given a solid, if rather slow, start by Kilburn and Littlewood, who made 37 together before Kilburn was out for 13.

Littlewood made 29 before he was out at 51, and from that point wickets fell steadily in the face of good, accurate bowling from Guy and Trueman.

Pickersgill provided brief resistance, but when he was tragically run out in the thirty-second over, Cawthorne's last hope of a reasonable score disappeared. The innings closed in the forty-third over at 90 all out, with bowlers Guy and Trueman finishing with figures of five for 35 and four for 52 respectively.

Denby Dale made a steady reply with Hirst and Frankland (L) looking solid and safe. After losing Hirst at 17, B Howells held the innings together, sharing good partnerships with Frankland (20), B Lucas (12) and finally an

unbroken one with Trueman (27 not out).

Howells finished with 37 not out, but Trueman won the pan of the match award.
