

## Denby Dale Heritage Graphic

This is the Denby Dale Cricket Club pavilion. A Sport England Lottery grant made to the club meant that the club was able to build the new pavilion in 1999. The £370,000 building was opened in time for the 1999 season. It boasts superb changing facilities and a stair-lift for disabled people and is also home to the club's tea room.



The main road goes past Denby Dale's ground and, with the local bowling club nearby, drivers can expect a fair bit of congestion on matchdays!
