



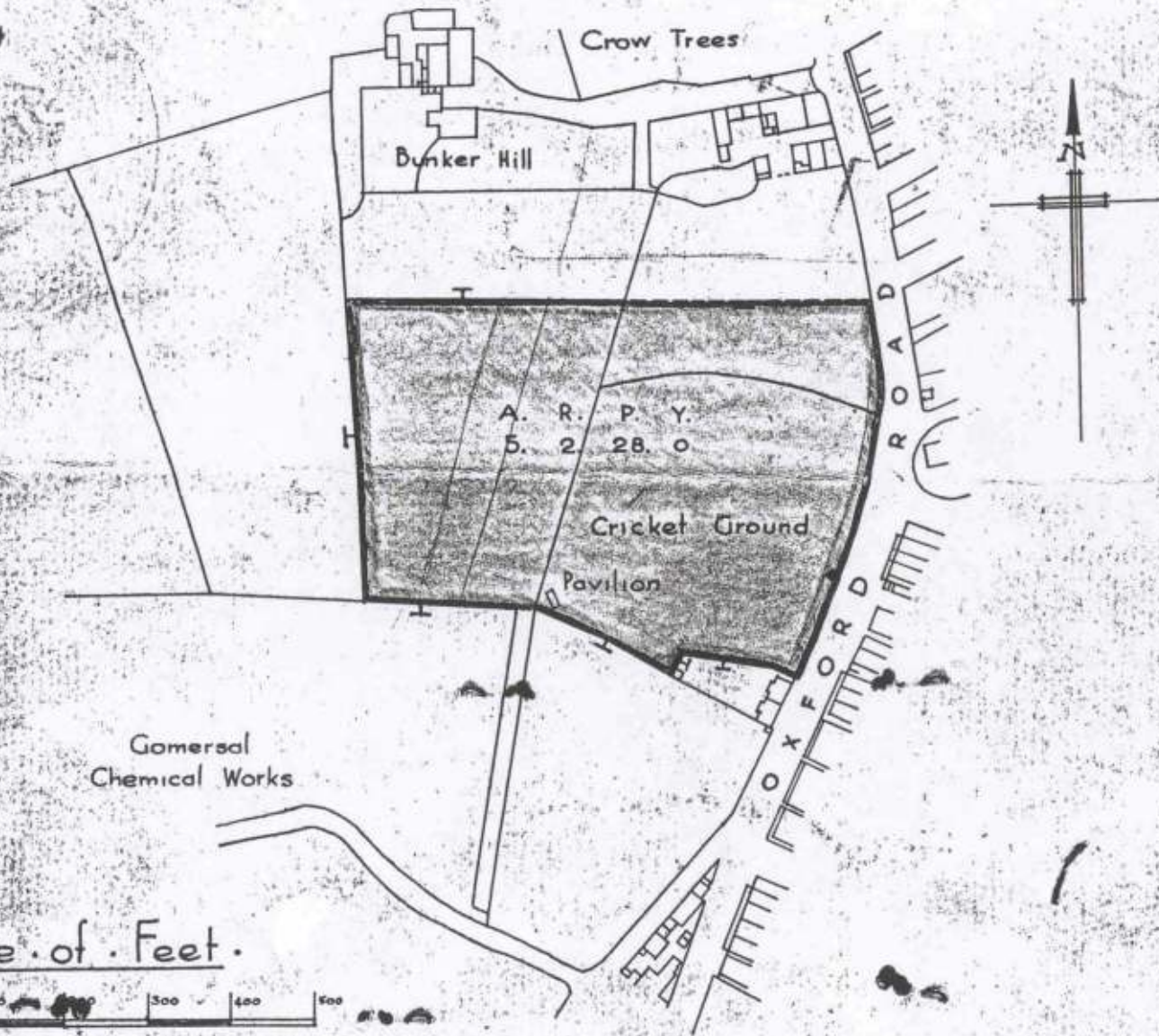

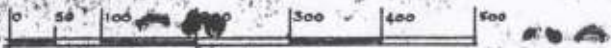

MEMORANDUM: By an Agreement dated the 1st day of March 1972 and made between Fred Dodgson Speak Jeffrey Riley Wilkinson and John Ellis Moore of the one part and the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Spenborough of the other part the said Fred Dodgson Speak Jeffrey Riley Wilkinson and John Ellis Moore gave up and dedicated to the public a piece of land containing an area of 90 square yards or thereabouts and agreed thereby that if called upon so to do by the Corporation within 21 years from the date thereof they would at the expense of the Corporation prove title to and as Trustees by a proper Deed of Conveyance grant or convey to the Corporation the said piece of land in fee simple

By a Conveyance dated the 3rd day of May 1973 made between John Ellis Moore Fred Dodgson Speak Albert Brian Moore Garry Wilkinson of the one part and Hackney Estates Limited of the other part a piece of land containing an area of 2.469 square yards or thereabouts was conveyed to the said Hackney Estates Limited in fee simple.
