

Minutes of a Meeting of the General Committee held in the
Clubhouse on Thursday 30th July 1981

Mr. H. Schofield in the chair

10 members present

The secretary read the minutes of the last meeting and these were passed as a true record.

Pay Phone

The secretary reported that it would cost £75 to install and a quarterly rent of £16.38. On being questioned as to what happened to the monies in the box the secretary admitted he did not know but would find out.

Gas Supply

Mr. J. Barron stated that his company was still awaiting a supply to the pipe needed to make the necessary connection.

Resignation of Mr. J. Holroyd

The secretary read a letter of resignation from the captaincy of the 3rd eleven from Mr. J. Holroyd because in his opinion certain members of the club thought that the 3rd XI should not have equitable use of the club facilities. Mr. Holroyd stated that should the committee wish him to enlarge upon this he would be glad to do so. However, as Mr. Holroyd was not present at the meeting, it was decided to leave this until the next meeting, in the hope that it could be discussed in Mr. Holroyd's presence.

Treasurers Report

The treasurer gave a report on the club's current financial position, in which he stated that we had approximately £3,600 in the current account and £4.125 in the Building Society. He also stated that the new score box was paid for but there would be further expenditure when the electronics were put in, other than that there were no outstanding bills. The chairman thanked Mr. Oates for his report and remarked that we appeared to be in a good financial position.

Use of Tackle

The treasurer brought it to the notice of the committee that the cricket tackle was not being taken care of as well as it should be. After discussion it was agreed that a notice be put up drawing players attention to this.

Letter-Heads

On the chairmans strict instructions, the secretary was told to order some letter-heads for the club for the use of club officials.

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Pay Phone

Mr. Brian Winrow enquired if it was possible to install a pay phone, it was agreed that the secretary should obtain the details and report back to the committee.

Raffle prize for the Halifax Amateur League

Mr. Holroyd requested the committee to donate a bottle of Sherry for the raffle - this was agreed to.

Treasurers Report

Mr. J. Holroyd asked the chairman if the treasurer could give a report on the clubs financial position at the next meeting. The chairman said he would arrange this.

Date of Annual Dinner

Mr. Brian Winrow stated that this would be on Friday 23rd October at Elland C.C.

There being no other business the chairman declared the meeting closed.
