Comment from the Team

This Week; Paul Winrow - Vice captain & Domestic Pro

Welcome to the start of the 2004 Drakes Huddersfield Cricket League season. For Barkisland Cricket Club history will be made as Premiership cricket arrives for the very first time. Three years of hard work culminated at the end of last season with the first eleven running away with the Cedar Court Conference trophy. There were notable personal performances during the season but I must admit the team effort during the season was the deciding factor. There were no weak links and all players performed well above expectations.

The Premiership season promises to bring some scintillating cricket to Barkisland. The club will be hosting the likes of Delph and Dobcross, Kirkburton, Scholes and not forgetting the eagerly anticipated local derby against Elland. Players of the quality of Wasim Jaffer, Brandon Nash and Ryan Robinson will all be here to test their skills against us during the season.

With the talent available to Barkisland this season there is little doubt that we will be competing with the sides and players mentioned above. There are a few new faces which I would like to introduce. Firstly, there is our new overseas player. Kiwi, Ryan Webster, is an opening bowler and middle order batter who 'big' things are expected. He may not be seen on the pitch for a couple of weeks (due to injury during the warm up at last weeks game), but when available performances with bat and ball should be impressive. The seam bowling department will be led by Adam Robinson (and Ryan Webster), with back up from myself and Peter Ward. Our 3 spinners then provide us with the depth we require. On to the batting. There should be big seasons ahead for our top order. Jamie Summerscales should have another productive season, especially after his fine 78 last week at Linthwaite. It will be my job to assist at the top of the order with Dave Weston slotting in at number three. The middle order will then consist of our big hitters (Gary Colman, Ben Wells, Peter Ward, Ryan Webster and Tom Weston). Throw in skipper Andrew Fraine and we have batting all the way down the order. Last but not least Nick Oddy will provide a solid and reliable figure behind the stumps.

All the players are looking forward to this season with immense enthusiasm and are determined to prove we can compete at the higher level. Let's hope we can provide as much excitement and entertainment to you all as was achieved in 2003.
