

HANGING HEATON CRICKET CLUB

R U L E S

(1) NAME OF CLUB AND OBJECTS

The Club will be known as the Hanging Heaton Cricket Club. The Objects of the Club are to provide the means of social intercourse, mutual helpfulness, mental and moral improvement and rational recreation.

(2) MEMBERSHIP

The Club shall consist of:-

- (a) Full Members.
- (b) Ground Members.
- (c) Ladies.

(3) ADMISSION OF MEMBERS

A candidate for election as a Full Member must be proposed and seconded by two financial members who must vouch from their personal knowledge, that the candidate will be a satisfactory member. (Note:- A financial member is a Full member whose subscriptions are paid up to date).

Each candidate must pay an entrance fee of 1/- on the submission of his application for membership; this fee will be refunded in the event of the application being refused.

The election of members rests entirely with the General Committee, and no candidate will be accepted for Full Membership under the age of 18 years.

The name, address and occupation of each candidate with the names of the proposer and seconder, will be posted in the Club for at least 7 days before the day that the candidate is submitted for election.

Ground Members are not subject to the above conditions and cannot enjoy the amenities of the club house, their membership simply covers the opportunity of being spectators of the various matches promoted by the Club.

(4) SUBSCRIPTIONS

The subscriptions and conditions are:-

Full Members 15/- per annum, payable each quarter in advance.

Ground Members 8/6d per annum payable before June 1st of each year.

Any member, not having paid his subscription within the quarterly period due and failing to do so within the first 10 days of the following quarter will be considered to be in arrears and shall cease to be a member.

The Secretary shall post a permanent list of all members showing clearly the date and amount of subscriptions paid, and in addition a separate list of individual members in arrears, and no such last mentioned members will be allowed to use the club or be considered a financial member.

Any member may advise the Secretary, in writing, of his inability, owing to extreme circumstances to pay the previous quarterly subscriptions, when the Committee may give directions for his name to be excluded from the list of members in arrears and allow him to continue the privileges of membership under such conditions as may be determined by the Committee.

(5) CHANGES OF ADDRESS

Any member changing his address must notify the Secretary immediately.

(6) CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

A person shall cease to be a member -
