PROTEST AGAINST DECISIONS OF UMPIRE AT CENTRAL LEAGUE MATCH.

A meeting of the Central Cricket League was held at the Railway Hotel, Shepley, on Thursday. Mr. L. Green was in the chair.

A letter from the Thurstonland C.C. protesting against the umpire's decisions at a match played with Holmebridge last Saturday was read.

The protest was that an umpire who was not the one appointed by the League, but who belonged to a local club, umpired at the match and gave some very biased decisions.

The captain of the Holmebridge team said that Holmebridge had nothing whatever to do with the appointment of the umpire, but that the umpire appointed by the League had asked the umpire in question to take his place at Holmebridge.

The chairman (Mr. Green), said that this was a wrong thing to do without the consent of the League, but after hearing both sides, he was of the opinion that the umpire's decisions had not been biased in any way.

This view was also taken by the delegates.
