**Six Points' Lead in Section "A"**

HALL BOWER almost made sure of the championship of Section "A" of the Huddersfield and District League by their success over Lascelles Hall on Saturday.

Lascelles Hall took first knock, and were all out for 96. The home side lost three wickets cheaply, but Parnment, Crowther and Mallinson kept up their ends, and improved the score. Mallinson was the highest scorer with 25. There was some good fielding by the Hall Bower side. Horafall, the captain and wicket-keeper, took three catches, and J. Hirst, fielding at mid-wicket, took another three.

Booth, the professional, and Tom Oldham, the opening batsmen, seemed to have little difficulty with the bowling of Hirst and Alec Lodge. When he had scored 17 Oldham was bowled by Hirst, and J.
